

## Important Update on the Parleys Canyon Proposed Quarry October 2023

## Parleys Canyon is Still Under Threat and We Need Your Help

On October 5<sup>th</sup>, John Persons from the Utah Division of Air Quality (DAQ), said in about three weeks the DAQ will release their response to about 1,400 comment letters and reports sent on July 27<sup>th</sup>. This will be an important event and the public should have this updated information.

Timeline on what has happened in the past 5 months:

May: The DAQ issued its Intent to Approve notice for the air quality plan submitted by Granite Construction and

June: On the 22<sup>nd</sup> a public comments hearing and rally was held at the DAQ office with live news coverage. Thank

you to all the letter writers, commenters, and rally participants.

July: Many letters were sent to DAQ during July. Again, thank you for all your efforts and support.

October: The DAQ response will be released by the end of the month. We do not know the DAQ's position; however,

it is time to fire up, rally around, and get prepared for the next action.

Also, please note on October 6<sup>th</sup>, Salt Lake County filed its 'Answer' in the 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court to Tree Farm,

LLC's Complaint & Petition for Judicial Review filed on May 11, 2022.
