Subject: Notice of Planning Petition - Text Amendment to consolidate parking garage regulations in the downtown districts

Hi all,

The Planning Division is processing an application for a text amendment that will consolidate the parking garage regulations in the downtown zoning districts. This amendment will move the regulations to one location to simplify the existing code language and eliminate conflicts. The intent and purpose of these standards (to screen parking garages and not allow parking garages at the street level or in front of buildings) will remain. If we identify additional conflicts related to the parking garage standards during the review process, those conflicts will also be corrected as part of this amendment.

I've attached a draft of the proposed ordinance language for your review and a formal letter requesting input from your recognized organization. As a recognized community

organization, you have 45 days from the date of this e-mail to provide comments on the proposed petition. The 45-day review period will end on **March 23rd, 2025**. Please let me know if you would like Planning Staff to present the proposed changes at one of your organization's meetings.
